ADVISORY

Pursuant to the proclamation extending the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in Metro Manila and four (4) provinces (Cavite, Laguna, Rizal and Bulacan), the NVBSP - Information Management Unit (NVBSP - IMU) shall implement the guidelines on the imposition of ECQ and the Stringent Social Distancing Measures over the NCR plus bubble, effective 00:00 (12 A.M) of April 05, 2021 and expiring on 00:00 (12 A.M) April 15, 2021.

Therefore, the staff of NVBSP - IMU shall continue to perform functions from home and modify the delivery of services. Below are the details on how to access the support and services:
